REGULATION

2024 European SAMBO Championship for Sports SAMBO Adults (M-F), Combat SAMBO for Adults (M-F), Sport SAMBO Juniors / Youth in Novi-Sad, Serbia from 7th to 13th of May 2024

1. General terms.

- 1.1 The European Sambo Championship 2024 (sport sambo among men and women and combat sambo among men and women, sport sambo among juniors, sport sambo among youth) (from now on referred to as the European Sambo Championship 2024) shall be held in accordance with the current International Sambo Rules approved by the International Sambo Federation (FIAS).
- 1.2 The European Sambo Championship 2024 will be held in accordance with the current regulations of the European Sambo Federation (ESF) and the International Sambo Federation (FIAS).
- 1.3 The European Sambo Championship 2024 will be organized by the European Sambo Federation (ESF) and the Sambo Federation of Serbia.
- 1.4 The European Sambo Championship 2024 is held to popularize and develop sambo as an Olympic sport in Europe and to strengthen international sports ties between the members of the European Sambo Federation (ESF) in Europe.

2. Competition organizers.

2.1 General management of the organization and holding of the European Sambo Championship 2024 shall be the responsibility of the European Sambo Federation (ESF) and the Sambo Federation of Serbia.

3. Dates and venue.

- 3.1 The European Sambo Championship 2024 shall be held from 7 to May 13, 2024.
- 3.2 Competition venue: SPENS, Sutjeska 2, 21000 Novi Sad, Serbia.
- 3.3 Accreditation of the participants of the European Sambo Championship 2024 will be held at the hotel:
Hotel Putnik (Ilije Ognjanovica 24, 21000 Novi-Sad, Serbia).
- 3.4 The participants of the European Sambo Championships 2024 will be accommodated in:
Hotel Putnik (Ilije Ognjanovica 24, 21000 Novi-Sad, Serbia);
Prezident Hotel Novi Sad (Futoška 109, 21000 Novi-Sad, Serbia).
- 3.5 The Congress of the European Sambo Federation will be held at the hotel:
Prezident Hotel Novi Sad (Futoška 109, 21000 Novi-Sad, Serbia).

4. Terms of participation.

4.1 The National Sambo Federations (NSF), affiliated with the European Sambo Federation (ESF), have the right to participate in the European Sambo Championship 2024.

4.2 Each National Sambo Federation must pay an annual membership fee to the European Sambo Federation in accordance with the rules of the European Sambo Federation (ESF) in the amount of 300 euros. National Sambo Federations that do not pay the annual fee will not be allowed to participate in the competitions.

4.3 At most, 1 athlete from the national team in each weight category is allowed to participate in the competitions.

4.4 Registration of delegations to the European Sambo Championship 2024 shall be done ONLY through the FIAS electronic system (FIAS Database) at <https://fms.sambo.sport/login>. Admission of athletes to the competitions will be carried out only through the FIAS Database. Any questions related to registration in the FIAS Database should be addressed to FIAS at the following address: info@sambo-fias.com, as well as checked at the FIAS YouTube channel: <https://www.youtube.com/playlist?list=PLkng14WT2Ofxg7pq0jh9HplMmmag72sdF>.

4.5 The deadline for registration in the FIAS Database is April 30, 2024.

4.6 National Federations that have not submitted their entries through the FIAS Database by April 30, 2024, will be required to pay a fine of USD 200 for each delegate not registered at the event (registration in the FIAS Database on the website will be mandatory in any case).

4.7 Each athlete of the National Sambo Federation must pay a license fee of 60 USD, which includes international sports insurance for selected competitions from the FIAS calendar. 4.8 Each National Sambo Federation coach must hold a FIAS coaching certificate and pay a license fee of 60 USD, which includes international sports insurance for selected competitions from the FIAS calendar.

Note:

* Athletes (men and women combat sambo) in weight categories marked with an asterisk (*) take part in the ranking selection for the 2025 World Games.

** Athletes in the youth age category may be allowed to participate in junior competitions, and athletes in the junior age category may be allowed to participate in adult competitions. At the same time, registration in the FIAS Database is done separately for each age group.

*** The weigh-in procedure shall be conducted in accordance with the program for each age group separately (if an athlete competes in two age groups, he/she shall undergo the weigh-in procedure for each age group respectively).

5. Technical specifications.

5.1 The European Sambo Championship 2024 shall be held in accordance with the current rules of the European Sambo Federation (ESF) and the International Sambo Rules (FIAS).

5.2 The competitions shall be officiated by the panel of referees approved by the Chairman of the Judging Commission of the International Sambo Federation (FIAS).

5.3 Only international category referees can referee the competitions (B category minimum).

5.4 The draw will be conducted automatically through the FIAS Electronic System (random selection/distribution).

5.5 Sport SAMBO official competitions shall be held with finalists' elimination and repechage bouts.

5.6 Combat SAMBO official competitions shall be held with elimination without repechage bouts.

5.7 Team medal count is conducted unofficially according to the Olympic principle (no awards).

5.8 The Organizing Committee guarantees to provide all the participants with first aid (if necessary).

5.9 Each athlete must undergo a medical examination before leaving for the competition, and the results of the medical examination must be included in the application or medical certificate.

5.10 Each athlete must have a sambo uniform (red/blue) with a FIAS license and a patch (in full compliance with FIAS requirements) on the back of his sambo uniform consisting of his surname and the abbreviation of his country's name or FIAS abbreviation as decided by FIAS.

5.11 Athletes who have discrepancies between the sambo uniform and the patch on the back of their uniform with the requirements of the FIAS International Rules are not allowed to participate in the competitions.

5.12 During accreditation, delegates of all countries must provide the Organising Committee with a short version (not more than 30 seconds) of the respective anthem in electronic form and two 2x1m national flags.

6. Anti-Doping.

6.1 The doping tests are carried out by the official Anti-Doping organization or sample collection provider recognized and approved by WADA.

6.2 The selection of athletes would be according to the 2021 FIAS Anti-Doping rules, based on the 2021 WADA Anti-Doping Code.

6.3 After receipt of notification until arrival at the point of doping control, the selected athletes will always be accompanied by the organization's official representative.

6.4 The selected athlete has the right to be accompanied by one representative who helps him with translation.

6.5 The official language during the doping control is English

6.6 Suppose the Organizing Committee does not provide participants with accreditation with the photo on it. In that case, the selected athlete must provide a valid passport or identity document at the point of doping control.

6.7 All athletes must plan in advance the date and the time of their departure from the competitions, considering that any athlete could be chosen for the doping test.

7. Entries.

7.1 The Organizing Committee of the competitions will provide accommodation with breakfast and dinner (only in the specified official hotels) and transfer for the National Sambo Federations that submit their application **by March 25, 2024.**

7.2 Suppose the application for accommodation with breakfast and dinner (only in the specified official hotels) and transfer from the National Sambo Federation is submitted later than March 25, 2024. In that case, the competition's Organizing Committee reserves the right to refuse to provide accommodation and transfers.

7.3 Applications for booking accommodation and transfers shall be submitted to the Competition Organizing Committee in accordance with Annex No.1 and Annex No.2.

7.4 All participants who require a visa to enter Serbia must apply for a visa at the Serbian Embassy in their country. The visa fee for entry to Serbia, which can be arranged for each participant, must be paid independently by the National Sambo Federation or the individual participant. The cost of the visa fee may vary from country to country. **The Sambo Federation of Serbia will provide the necessary visa support, subject to prior notification, until March 15, 2024.**

7.5 Applications for visa support shall be submitted to the Competition Organizing Committee in accordance with Annex No. 3.

8. Financial conditions.

8.1 The Sambo Federation of Serbia provides transfer from the Nikola Tesla International Airport (Belgrade) to the official hotel and back, as well as transfer from the official hotel to the competition venue and back at 20.00 euros for each participant.

8.2 The Sambo Federation of Serbia provides accommodation in a hotel with breakfast and dinner (only in the specified official hotels) at the rate of 100.00 Euros per participant per night (double accommodation and meals 2 times a day) and 150 Euros per participant per night (single accommodation and meals 2 times a day) for the whole period of the European Sambo Championship 2024.

8.3 Other additional costs for food and accommodation are to be paid by each participant independently.

8.4 The accommodation period is 2 days minimum for each delegation member (official hotels only).

8.5 The Heads of Delegations shall settle all financial issues and meet accreditation requirements on the day of arrival.

8.6 In case the delegation participating in the competitions or members of the delegation who are not officials organize their accommodation and meals (accommodation not in official hotels), the National Sambo Federation shall pay an accreditation fee of 150 (one hundred and fifty) euros for each member of the delegation to the Organizing Committee of the competitions. No transfer is provided to the participants in this case.

8.7 The Organizing Committee provides transfers, meals, and accommodation for the President of the European Sambo Federation (ESF), Secretary General of the European Sambo Federation (ESF), Chairman of the Referee Commission of the European Sambo Federation (ESF), Chief Referee, Chief Secretary, and 20 referees in accordance with the rules of the European Sambo Federation (ESF).

8.8 Payment for the fare of the referees included in the official list of FIAS referees (chief referee, chief secretary, minimum 18 referees) and payment of their salaries shall be provided by the International Sambo Federation (FIAS).

9. Awarding.

9.1 Prize-winning athletes shall be awarded medals and diplomas.

9.2 A red SAMBO uniform is required at the official ceremonies.

9.3 The national anthem will be played during the awarding ceremony, and the flag will be raised.
